
# Seniors, Class of 1959





Jam England

Take a squad of sound gridmen, add a football or two, and sprinkle generously with fumbles: you get the number 5 spot in the South Suburban League for Leyden's Varsity footballers in one of the toughest years of competition. Incidentally, this was the last year a Leyden football team would compete in the League.

On September 12, Leyden's Eagles were invited to Arlington Heights to open the 1958 season. Perhaps the results of the opener were to be an omen of the forthcoming season, as the Cardinals spurred onward from a scoreless first half to smother the Eagles 16-0 in the last half. Spirit was up for the first home game, against Elmwood Park, but in vain, as the Eagles fell 6-0 in a close game.

Enthusiasm dwindled slightly now, for the Engles were scheduled to meet Bloom, whose varsity gridders were picked as one of the five best teams in the state An Eagle victory could really shake up the South Suburban League, and throw some of the "experts" for a big surprise also. Leyden fans foresaw a league title as the locals pushed out in front of Bloom 6-0. The determined Eagles bitterly held the six-point lead until, with one minute remaining in the first half, Bloom completed a long 60yard pass for a touchdown. The conversion gave Bloom a 7-6 halftime lead.

However, Coach Bujan's boys really deserve applause for that game, losing 13-7

against a team which is rated to beat you 63-0.

Kankakee managed to eke out a 20-19 victory over the boys from Leyden, a con-troversial kick-for-extra-point making up for the 1-point difference.


However, the everfighting Eagles overcame these setbacks to trounce Lockport, 20-0. Gefting off to an early start, the Varsity men tallied three times in the first half. But things weren't so gay on October 24 as locals lost a hard-fought battle to Thornton Fractional. The visiting Meteors from Fractional heavily guarded their goal to win by one touchdown.

Pep Club attended the away Argo game to cheer our team on to a 7-0 victory despite the Argo homecoming rituals. Then all awaited the big Homecoming game against Blue Island—and the bottom fell out. A 94 yard run by a Blue Island back started the way for a 20-7 upset by the visitors.

Dismal over this Homecoming upset, and with school spirit ebbing, it was a long ride both up and back to Harvey, as the South Surburan League champions pounded out a 28-0 win in our final South Suburban football contest.





## VARSITY BASKETBALL



The thrills of basketball season were with us once again as the Varsity Eagles opened the 1958-59 early last November. Lacking experience with only two returning lettermen, the Eagles fought to a final

season record of five wins and seventeen losses.

A disappointing 61-60 loss to Fenton opened the Varsity cagers' season. Two nights later they dropped a close contest to West Niles as basketball play opened for the season in the Leyden fieldhouse. SSL Conference play found Coach Lou Granzin's cagers first matched against Lockport and last year's SSL champions, Thornton.

The Eagles began to take shape as they romped over Fractional by sixteen points to account for their first conference victory. Returning as Hardwood Holiday champions, the Eagles surrendered their tourney

championship to Niles.

Dropping to Elmwood Park in a close contest, the Varsity cagers defeated Palatine 64-51 in a thrilling contest the following evening. As they returned to conference play, successive losses to Bloom and Kankakee were handed the Eagles, but they soon came back to walk over Argo. Dropping again to tough SSL opponents Lockport and Thornton, the season looked despressing for the basketmen.

But once again the Leyden cagers' showed their winning potential as they chalked up 71 points to come out on top of Fractional 71-57. Falling back into a slump, the Eagles were successively edged out by Elgin, Blue Island, Bloom, and Kankakee. The Bloom contest provided the Eagles most exciting battle of the season as the Eagles led through-

out most of the game, dropping only in final seconds.

A successful season finish was claimed by the cagers as they polished off Argo 66-53. The Argo win represented two milestones in Leyden's basketball history—its last contest as a member of the South Suburban Conference, and its sixteenth straight victory pared with no losses against Argo.

Entering the Glenbrook Regionals the Eagles were knocked out of


tourney play when they fell to Niles 57-48.

The Varsity Cagers finished the season sixth in conference with a four and ten record. Sophomore Jim Rodgers led the Eagles scoring and finished fifth in SSL scoring. Jim was also selected to hold the guard's position on the second SSL all-star team.

With almost an entire squad of returning lettermen to comprise next year's squad, Coach Lou Granzin has high expectations for next

year's Varsity cagers.







At the State Meet, Ron Vonesh finished twelfth.

Vonesh was chosen the most valuable cross country runner. Nick Sayers and Randy Eden were named outstanding Frosh-Soph runner and most valuable frosh runner, respectively.





wrestling success to Leyden.












# .... Encourages Good Sportsmanship
